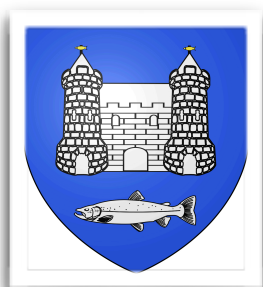


Ton Bale Tregarvan (Marche de Trégarvan)
